The Canadian Naval Memorial Trust (CNMT) is a voluntary organization of 1000 Trustees from across Canada and around the world dedicated to preserving HMCS SACKVILLE, the last WWII corvette, which was designated the Naval Memorial of Canada in 1985. The CNMT seeks to establish a permanent setting for the ship within a new structure on the Halifax Waterfront. The selection of a design architect for this structure will be made through national competition.

The CNMT now wishes to engage the services of a suitably qualified individual or company to fill the role of project manager for:

- the production of the Project Brief; and
- the conduct of the Architect selection process

The successful applicant will have demonstrated previous experience in managing large projects with a construction cost in excess of \$50 million; an ability to work with voluntary organizations and an interest in the naval heritage of Canada.

Expressions of interest are to be delivered or emailed to the undersigned, not later than 20 February, 2012 and are to contain a current resume, the names of three references and the expected form of compensation. The CNMT reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications or to further pursue the application that it considers to be in its own best interest.
